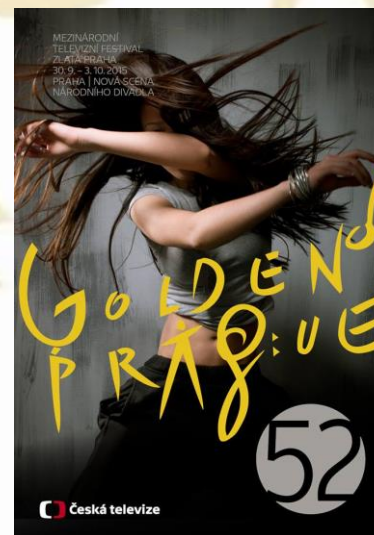

## 53<sup>rd</sup> year of the ITF Golden Prague



**Date:** 28 September - 1 October 2016

**Place:** New Stage of the National Theatre

**Extended scope:** music, dance and **theatre** programmes

- Cover new crossover projects of which is difficult to classify (interweaving of movement and music theatre, pantomime, new circus etc.)
- Capture richness of genres of Staging Arts
